

Leave the M5 at junction 7 (signed Worcester (S), Evesham

Join the B4084 following signs for Pershore.
Continue on the B4084 for 3.8 miles passing the Plough & Harrow Public House on the right.

Turn left into the Drakes Broughton Business Park. When you enter the Business Park, Joerns Healthcare is located on the right-hand side (see inset).
